REQUIREMENTS

- ⇒ Attend all Leadership Skills/Team Building sessions.
- ⇒ Volunteer for a 12-month period at a nonprofit organization selected by the Chamber. (*Current nonprofit volunteer work not applicable*)

TUITION

Tuition is **\$695/person**, which covers all expenses of the program. Tuition is payable in full by December 16, 2016. **No refunds** will be made after that date.
